



Walk Description

Title: Eaton Socon – St Neots – Circular

Map: OS Explorer 208

Distance: 3¼ Miles

Ascent: 15ft

Start: Car Park – The Paddock - St Neots - PE19 7SD – MapRef TL 17943 60101

- 1) From the car park walk north to the road – Turn RIGHT and walk over the bridge and cross **the River Great Ouse** into **St Neots** – On reaching the **Market Place** on the right turn RIGHT and walk around the **Market Place** to **South Street** – Turn RIGHT and walk to **Brook Street** – At **Hen Brook** cross over the brook on the bridge in front of you – Walk to the paved path and turn RIGHT follow the path to the **Bowling Club** and follow the path RIGHT to the river – The path soon bears left and meets a school on the left – Look for a footpath on the RIGHT and walk to a road – At the road turn RIGHT and walk through to the river – Follow the path to the **Coneygeare Car Park**. (¾ Mile)
- 2) Keep to the left and follow the access road to the **St Neots Camping and Caravanning Club Site** – Just before the entrance to the site bear LEFT on to a footpath and walk to a field – Turn LEFT then RIGHT and follow the track to a gap in the hedge in front of you and on into **Barford Pocket Park** – Continue on the track and cross an access road – Walk to a footbridge with **Eynesbury Manor Marina** on the left – Continue on the path until it meets the **River Great Ouse**. (1½ Miles)
- 3) Turn RIGHT and follow the riverside path with the river on your left for 1 mile until you return to the **Coneygeare Car Park** – Cross over the river by a footbridge on the LEFT and continue in the same direction away from the river to a crossroads of paths – Go straight over and bear RIGHT in a 1 o'clock direction – The path meets some trees and circles the trees to the LEFT until it reaches a lake on the right – Here head towards the café and the start of the walk.
