



Walk Description

Title: Denton - Paradise Ponds - Chadstone

Map: OS Explorer 207

Distance: 3½ Miles

Ascent: 238ft

Start: The Red Lion Pub - 1 Main Street – Denton - NN7 1DQ – MapRef SP 83789 58052

- 1) Facing away from the pub turn left and walk for ¼ to the outskirts of the village – Where the road bends left take a waymarked footpath in front of you – Keep to the right of the field to a fence – Go over the fence and head straight across the field towards a hedge – Go through a gap in the hedge in front of you into a small field – Continue in the same direction to a fence – Go over the fence and bear half right across the field aiming towards **Whiston Slade Farm** – Go on through a hedge and continue towards the farm – At the farm walk through the farm yard to the access road – Walk on the access road to a road. (1 Mile)
- 2) Turn right and walk on the road to a waymarked bridleway – Turn right and follow the bridleway to **Chadstone Lodge** – Here the path joins an access road – Turn right and walk to the **Paradise Ponds** on the right – The access road now climbs into **Chadstone**. (2¼ Miles)
- 3) Go past some buildings on the right and at small triangular green turn right and take a footpath into a small paddock - Go through the paddock and into the next field – Head left to the corner and a stile – Now cross the arable field heading to the right of **Castle Ashby Lodge** – Continue on through a hedge and then to a brook – Cross the brook and turn left – Walk to a bridge on the left – Here turn right and walk to a gap in the hedge on the left – Cross the field to the corner of a hedge – Walk on with the hedge on the right – At a gap turn right and walk across the field to a stile and a road – Go left then right and follow the access road to a footpath which leads back the **Red Lion** pub and the start.
