



Walk Description

Title: Bozeat – Horn Wood - Easton Maudit

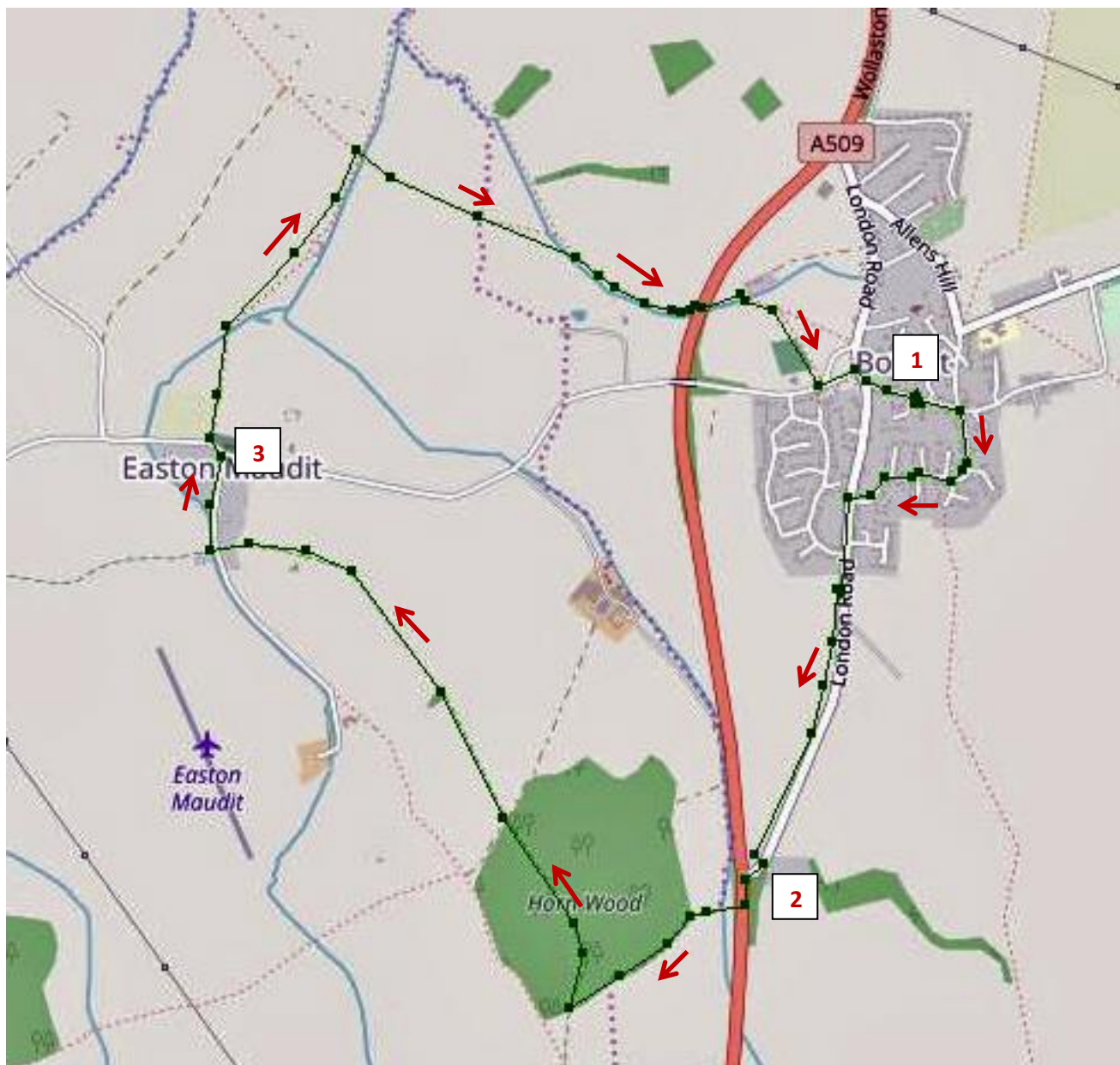
Map: OS Explorer 224

Distance: 4¼ Miles

Ascent: 189ft

Start: High Street – Bozeat - NN29 7NF – MapRef SP907590

- 1) Walk East to the crossroads at Cambell Square – Turn right into Church Lane – Walk past the Doctors Surgery on the left the road becomes St Marys Road – Follow St Marys Road to the junction with London Road – Turn left and walk South for 200 metres – Leaving the village look for a gap in the hedge on the right once through the gap turn left - Keeping the hedge on the left walk downhill to the A509 road. (1 Mile)
- 2) At the A509 cross the road and turn left – Walk on the verge for 50 metres then turn right on to a path that leads to a kiss gate – Go through the gate and walk to a track – Turn left and with the woods on your right walk uphill for ¼ mile – Look for a bridle path (track) on the right into **Horn Wood** – Take this track and walk through the woods – On emerging from the woods cross a track and continue straight on across two arable fields – At the third arable field turn left and walk to a pasture field – Walk across this field into **Easton Maudit**. (2½ Miles)
- 3) Turn right at the road and walk through the village to the church – Turn left then immediately right onto a track – Follow the track to a gate here the track becomes a footpath – Continue on past a barn on the right to a footbridge on the right – Cross the bridge and keeping a hedge on the left walk to a stile – Go over the stile and follow the path aiming for a footbridge in the right hand corner of the field – Cross the bridge and turn right follow the edge of the field to the A509 road – Cross the road and go over a stile follow the path to a footbridge – Cross the footbridge and aim for a kiss gate to the left of Bozeat Cemetery. On past the Cemetery on the right to a road – Cross the road and turn left walk to the centre of the village - Cross the road into the High Street and walk back to the start.
