



Walk Description

Title: Paxton Pits Circular

Map: OS Explorer 225

Distance: 3¾ Miles

Ascent: 32ft

Start: Paxton Pits Visitor Centre - High Street - Little Paxton - PE19 6ET –
MapRef TL 19548 62959

- 1) Facing away from the car park turn LEFT and walk past the visitor centre on the right and then turn RIGHT on to a footpath – Walk past the visitor centre on the right into a rough pasture field – Follow the clear path as it bears to the right – At a gap in the hedge it bears left through the hedge – With a lake on the left continue on the path which bears right then left then right again before reaching a T junction. (½ mile)
- 2) Turn RIGHT and walk through the trees on reaching some allotments look for a footpath on the LEFT – Follow the path between the allotments on the right and Hayling Lake on the left to another T junction. Turn LEFT and follow the path with the lake on the left and some houses on the right. At the T junction turn LEFT and follow the path with the lake on the left – At the end of the lake continue straight on – Soon the path joins the river Great Ouse on the right – Follow the path by the river to where the path bears left away from the river turn RIGHT on to the riverside path. (1¼ Miles)
- 3) Continue on the path by the river for ¾ mile – Here the path bears left away from the river – Ignore a path on the left and walk a few metres further to a T junction on a bend – Turn RIGHT and walk back to the river on the right – After a few metres by the river the path bears left away to a T junction – Turn LEFT and follow the track with a lake on the left until you reach the quarry buildings on the right. (2¾ Miles)
- 4) Walk on over the quarry access road to a footpath on the LEFT by the access road – Follow the footpath with the road on the left – On reaching some trees turn RIGHT on to a path that leads to another lake – At the lake turn LEFT and with the lake on your right walk until the path re-joins the road – Follow the road to a T junction – Turn RIGHT and walk back to the start.
