



Walk Description

Title: Felmersham – Harrold - Pavenham - Radwell

Map: OS Explorer 208

Distance: 10½ Miles

Ascent 474ft

Start: The Sun - Grange Road – Felmersham - MK43 7EU – MapRef SP 99105

- 1) Facing away from the pub turn right and walk to a waymarked footpath on the left – Follow the path through **Wills Farm** and on through a short scrubby area into a field – Keep to the right follow a hedge on the right to some trees – Go through the trees follow the path which does a small dog leg and emerges into a field – With the hedge on your right continue on the path (ignoring a gateway on your right) – Go through a gap at the end of the field and continue in the same direction with a fence on your left – On to a bridge over a ditch and then across the field to an access road – Turn right and follow the road to a T junction. Turn right and walk for 200 metres to a waymarked footpath on the left – Follow the footpath to the **River Ouse** and turn left – Follow the riverside path for ¼ mile – The path then leaves the river and crosses three fields to a track – Turn right on to the track and follow it over the **River Ouse** past a mill into **Odell**. (2½ Miles)
- 2) At the village green bear left past the bell pub and walk into **Harrold Country Park** – Walk on past the lake on your right to the **Visitor Centre** – Retrace your steps back to **Odell** and on past the mill back on to the track – Do not turn left on to the footpath but continue on the track uphill to a road. (5 Miles)
- 3) Turn left then after 100 metres turn right on to a waymarked footpath – Follow the path through two fields keeping to the left by a hedge – Cross straight over the third field and follow the path through a right left dog leg into another field – Follow the hedge on your left to the corner of the field – Bear left keeping the hedge on your left and walk to some woods (**Greens Spinney**) – Bear right at the woods and walk to the end of the woods on your left – Turn left and go through a gap in the hedge in front of you – Turn right and with the hedge on your right walk to the corner of the field and a bridleway – Turn left and follow the track across a field to a junction – turn left and after 100 metres right (**the path on the ground does not follow the line on the map**) and walk to a road. (7 Miles)
- 4) Turn right and walk for 100 metres to a waymarked footpath on the left – Take the path through the golf course keeping to the waymarked path – The path follows the edge of the golf course to a track (Bridleway) – Turn left and soon the track exits the course into a field – Keep to the right and walk on into the next field – Still keeping to the right go on into the next field – Head across the next field keeping to the left of **Hall Farm** walk to a road and **Radwell**. (8 Miles)

- 5) Cross the road and take the left fork into **Moor End Road** – Walk through the village for ¼ mile and turn left into a minor road – Follow the road to a T junction with **Moor End Lane** – Cross over on to an access track – Turn left at the end of the short track on to a footpath on the left – Follow the footpath with a hedge on the right – Turn right at the end of the hedge and with the hedge on your right walk to the corner of the field – Go through a gap in the hedge and walk across two fields in the same direction to an access road – Go straight on through **Brook Farm** at drop down to **Pinchmill Islands** and the **River Ouse**- Cross over the river backwaters and then over the main river – At a junction turn left and follow the path across water meadows and then alongside the river on your left to **Felmersham Bridge** – At the road turn left over the bridge – Fork left and walk past the church on your left – Walk uphill to Grange Road on your right – Turn right and walk back to the start.
