



Walk Description

Title: Cranford - Twywell

Map: OS Explorer 224

Distance: 4½ Miles

Ascent: 296ft

Start: Duck End - Cranford St John - NN14 4AE – MapRef SP 92827 77008

- 1) Facing north away from the main road walk to the left hand bend and on to a right hand turn – Walk past the church on the left and continue on the road for ½ mile – Where the road bends to the left carry straight on a waymarked footpath (track) – The track goes diagonally across the field to the corner of the field – Go through a gap between two hedges – Follow the path north with a hedge on the right – Where the hedge bends left go through a gap on the right – Turn left and walk between some trees on the left and a hedge on the right – Turn right and follow the edge of the field with the hedge on the right – On reaching the corner of the field go across a ditch and turn left – A hedge is now on your left – Follow the edge of the field to another gap – Once through the gap turn half right and walk diagonally across the field aiming for a solitary tree – Go past the tree on the left and go over a track and through a hedge into another field – Continue in the same direction across the field – On reaching a hedge turn right and follow the path into **Twywell**. (2 Miles)
- 2) At the road turn right and walk through **Twywell** – Just before **The Old Friar** pub take a waymarked (Hills & Dales) footpath on the right – Follow the lane which becomes a track – It bends to the right at some allotments then heads across a field towards some trees – On entering the trees the path bears right to a T junction – Turn left and follow the track through the trees – At a T junction turn right then left – Walk through the old quarry for ¼ mile where the path drops down into the quarry and turns left continue straight on out of the quarry. (3½ Miles)
- 3) Follow the path across a scrubby area of land to the track of a quarry railway – Turn left on to the track and walk to a path on the right – Take the path into a field with a hedge on the right – At the end of the field head across a another scrubby area bearing half left – Go into a large field and head half left to the far left hand corner of the field – Take the track to the right and look for a path on the left – Go across a brook and bear half right heading for the far left hand corner of the field – On reaching a road turn left back to the start.
