



## Walk Description

Title: Keysoe – Little Staughton

Map: OS Explorer 208

Distance: 7 Miles

No Stiles

Ascent: 300ft

Start: Keysoe Church – Keysoe – Bedfordshire - MK44 2HW – MapRef TL 07417 62458

- 1) Take the waymarked footpath opposite the church and follow the path through the equestrian centre ignoring any side paths – Pass through a hedge and head straight across an arable field to a road – Cross over to a waymarked footpath and walk diagonally across the field in a 2 o'clock direction – Cross over a stream and a crossing footpath and take the track in front of you – Walk gently uphill to a line of trees which the path passes through to another arable field – Go straight over the field through a hedge to a smaller field – With a hedge on the right walk into **Keysoe Row** and a road. (1 Mile)
- 2) Bear RIGHT then LEFT on to a waymarked footpath – Follow the path between some houses into a field – Turn LEFT and walk with some large gardens and paddocks on the left – The path turns into a track and where the track bears left take the Byway through some trees on the RIGHT – Walk through the small copse and follow the Byway as it winds its way through the trees and along the field margins – Where the Byway turns sharp right (MapRef TL 09650 61608) Bear LEFT on to a bridleway – Walk through the field with the hedge on your left – Pass through a hedge into another field and turn RIGHT follow the path into a more substantial woods – Walk through the woods – on emerging from the woods go straight over two fields to a road and the outskirts of **Little Staughton**. (2½ Miles)
- 3) Cross over and take the **Staughton Moor** road for a short distance – Turn LEFT on to a waymarked footpath – With a hedge on the left follow the path which soon bears to the right and climbs gently up hill to a track – Turn LEFT and follow the track past the site of a **Manor House** with a moat on the left – Ignore a path to the right and follow the track around to the LEFT still following the moat on the LEFT – At the end of the moat the track becomes a path between two fields – Head towards **Little Staughton** church in front of you – The path joins a road – Walk on the road into **Little Staughton** and a T junction – Turn RIGHT and walk through the village – Turn LEFT into **Green End** and walk to **The Crown Inn** on the left. (5 Miles)
- 4) Continue on the road which bears round to the right – Ignore the first footpath on the left but take the second waymarked path on the LEFT just past the large bungalow on the left – Follow the path which rises gently uphill – Ignore a track on the right but continue on to another track on the RIGHT – Follow the track which drops down to a ditch then rises again to enter into small copse – Pass through the copse into another field – Officially the footpath bears RIGHT and then LEFT to cross the field heading towards a single tree in the field. (**At the time of**

walking the farmer had redirected the footpath to head straight across the field to the tree) - Go past the tree and continue on the path to the far left hand corner of the field – At the corner turn RIGHT on to an access track which at a house on the left turns into **Mill Road** – Climb uphill into **Keysoe** and a road – Turn RIGHT then immediately LEFT into Church Road – Walk back to the start.
