



Walk Description

Title: Morcott - Harringworth

Map: OS Explorer 234

Distance: 7¼ Miles

Ascent: 500ft

Start: High Street – Morcott - LE15 9DN – MapRef SK 925007

- 1) Walk South East on Morcott High Street to the A6121 – Cross over and take a footpath opposite – Walk to the A47 and cross over to a minor road – Follow the road to **Barrowden** – At a crossroads take a footpath (Jurassic Way) opposite and follow the path to a disused railway track – Turn right on to the disused track and follow the path for 1 mile until you reach a bridle path – Turn left and walk to the **Turtle Bridge** over the River Welland. (2¾ Miles)
- 2) Continue to follow the Jurassic Way alongside the River Welland into **Harringworth**. At the minor road turn right and walk into the centre of the village on Wakerley Road – Carry straight on at a junction into Gretton Road – Continue until a footpath on the right – Take the footpath which goes under the railway – The path joins another from the left and then goes over the River Welland – Continue across two fields and then skirt around The Poplars and climb into **Seaton** – At the road turn right go past the church on the left hand side to a road junction. (5 Miles)
- 3) Turn right to a crossroads – Go straight over and walk on a minor road for ½ mile – Where the road bears right take a footpath (Rutland Round) straight in front of you – Follow the footpath North East for 1 mile until you reach the A47 road – Cross the road and take a diagonal footpath back to **Morcott** and the start.

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
