

## **Walk Description**

Title: Perry – Grafham Water Map: OS Explorer 225

Distance: 5 Miles Grade 1A No Stiles Ascent: 190ft

Start: The Wheatsheaf Pub – East Perry Road – Perry - PE28 0BX – MapRef TL

14802 66856 (Please ask for permission to park)

- 1) Facing away from the pub cross over the road into **Chichester Way** Follow the road which changes into a footpath and leads to the **Sailing Club** Just before the sailing Club look for a path on the LEFT Follow the path with the reservoir on the right On reaching an access road turn RIGHT and walk to the edge of the reservoir Bear LEFT and walk to the **Fishing Lodge and Café**. (¾ Mile)
- 2) Bear RIGHT and walk through the car park on the raised grassy area to a kissgate Follow the clear path which soon joins the main circular path around the reservoir Bear RIGHT and follow the main path After ¼ mile the main path bears RIGHT. (1¼ Miles)
- 3) Continue on the main path which soon enters **Littless Wood** follow the path through the wood for ½ mile until you reach a footpath on the LEFT at MapRef TL 12850 68192. (2¼ Miles)
- 4) Turn LEFT on to the **Three Shires Way** bridle path and follow the path around **Dudney Wood** Continue on ignoring a bridlepath on the left and carry on past **Lady Grove** Wood on the left At the end of the woods bear LEFT and follow the path with the woods on your left to a junction of paths Bear LEFT then RIGHT Walk with a hedge on your right Go past a Trig point on your right in the hedge Carry on the bridleway until you come to a junction of paths You are now back at point 3 above. (3¾ Miles)
- 5) Retrace your steps on the main path (Ignore a footpath to the right) back to the entrance to the car park Go into the car park and head across the grass to a kissgate Go through the gate and cross over the access road Retrace your steps back to the Sailing Club and Chichester Way to return to the pub.
