



## Walk Description

Title: Milton Ernest – River Ouse – Permitted Paths

Map: OS Explorer

Distance: 4¼ Miles

Ascent: 83ft

Start: Milton Ernest Garden Centre - Radwell Road - Milton Ernest - MK44 1SH –  
MapRef TL 01405 56126

- 1) Facing away from the garden centre walk to the **Radwell Road** and turn RIGHT – Walk to **Riverside View** and turn RIGHT continue to the end and enter a grass area – Turn RIGHT and follow the path to a gap in the hedge – Continue in the same direction across some scrub to another hedge and go through the gap into a field – Bear LEFT and follow the path to the **River Ouse** – Follow the path with the river on the left to the railway. (¾ Mile)
- 2) Continue straight on under the railway and follow the path with a hedge on the right for ¾ mile to an access track and storage area on the right – Bear LEFT through a large gap in the hedge in front of you and follow the path with the remains of a hedge on the right – The path bears round to the right and passes a scrubby area on the left before reaching a small copse on the right – Keep the left of the copse and continue on to meet a farm access track on the right – Ignore the track and walk with a hedge on the right until you reach the **River Ouse** – Turn RIGHT and walk to **Radwell Bridge**. (2¼ Miles)
- 3) Retrace your steps and walk alongside the **River Ouse** with the river on your right – Continue alongside the river for 1½ miles – Pass under the railway and bear LEFT back to point 2 – Turn RIGHT and retrace your steps with the river on your right and a field on the left – At the corner of the field turn LEFT – Ignore the path on the right and continue on with the garden centre on the right – Walk to the **Radwell Road** and turn RIGHT – Walk to the garden centre on the RIGHT and the start.
