



Walk Description

Title: Bryn Howel – Pontcysyllite Aquaduct

Map: OS Explorer 256

Distance: 7 Miles

Ascent: 1325ft

Start: Bryn Howel Hotel – Trevor - LL20 7UW - MapRef SJ 252418

- 1) From the hotel take the access road to a minor road – Turn left and walk to the A539 – Go straight across and follow a footpath which is an access road to some houses – Follow the road to the left and go past a caravan park on the right – As the path rises look for a footpath on the right (MapRef SJ 247423) – Take this path through **Trevor Hall Woods** – After 200 metres look for another path on the left (MapRef SJ 249242) and climb to the **Offas Dyke Path**. ($\frac{3}{4}$ Mile)
- 2) Turn left and follow the path - Soon you exit the woods and join a minor road (**Panorama Walk**) – Follow the road for $\frac{1}{2}$ mile – Take an access path on the right at MapRef SJ 235433 and follow the path north west – After 200 metres the path goes to the right and starts climbing soon it loops round to the right and climbs north east towards a ridge – Follow the path east and after crossing a track climb up to the ridge at MapRef SJ 239435. (2 $\frac{3}{4}$ Miles)
- 3) Turn right and follow a path along the ridge – The path now drops downhill for $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to reach a minor road – Take the footpath opposite and walk south east through **Trevor Hall Woods** until you meet another path (**Offas Dyke Path**) – Turn left and follow the path until you reach a minor road – The road bends around to the right and soon joins the A539 – Turn left and walk towards the village of **Trevor** – Before the village turn right on to a footpath which drops down across a disused railway line to the **Llangollen Canal** – Cross over the canal and turn left to walk along the towpath to the **Pontcysyllite Aqueduct & Trevor Basin Visitor Centre**. (5 $\frac{1}{4}$ Miles)
- 4) Turn right from the visitor centre to walk over the aqueduct – Retrace your steps - On your return look for a footpath on your right which drops down to the River Dee – At the river turn right and follow the river under the aqueduct for 100 metres and take a path to the right which crosses the B5434 to return to the towpath of the **Llangollen Canal** – Turn left and follow the towpath for 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ Miles to a bridge (MapRef SJ 250418) over the canal just past Bryn Howel Farm on your left – Go over the bridge and back to the start.
