



Walk Description

Title: Warmington - Nassington

Map: OS Explorer 227 & 234

Distance: 8¾ Miles

Ascent: 308ft

Start: Church Lane – Warmington - PE8 6TE – MapRef TL 078910

- 1) Facing away from the church turn left and walk to a T junction – Turn left and walk past the village shop on the left to another T junction – Turn left again into **Chapel Street** and follow the road to a small green – Turn left past the **Red Lion Pub** on the right – Once past the pub turn right on to a waymarked footpath – Walk across the field to the right hand corner and take the subway under the A605 – Walk to **Warmington Mill**. (½ Mile)
- 2) Just before the mill take a path on the right over the **River Nene** - Follow the path across the water meadow to a lock – Cross over the river by the lock – Turn half left and walk to a gap in the hedge in front of you – Follow the path (Nene Way) along a track – Where the track bears right continue straight on and follow the path until you reach a farm road – Turn left and walk past the farm buildings to **Fotheringhay Castle**. (1¾ Miles)
- 3) Continue on to a road – Go straight ahead past **Fotheringhay Church** on the left and on to a waymarked footpath on the right – Take the footpath to the left of a house into a field – Follow a hedge on the left – When the hedge bears left continue straight on across the field to a bridge over a brook – turn left and follow the brook on your left for ½ mile to a track – Turn right and follow the track uphill for ¾ mile until the track bears right – Look for a deep ditch on the left – Turn left keeping the ditch on the left – At the hedge on the right turn right keeping the hedge on the left – Cross a track and continue with the hedge on the left – Where the hedge bears left continue straight ahead across the field into **Nassington Playing Field**. Keep to the left of the buildings and take a path into **Nassington**. (4¼ Miles)
- 4) At the road turn right and walk to a T junction – Turn right and walk to a waymarked footpath on the left – Walk diagonally across the field to the far left hand corner – Go through a hedge and keeping a ditch on the left hand side walk through two fields – Go right round a small clump of trees and go diagonally across the field to a gap in the hedge in front – Go through the gap and continuing in the same direction walk to a disused railway line – Cross over and continue across the field towards the **River Nene** – At the river turn right and follow the river on the left to a bridge. (5¼ Miles)
- 5) Cross over the bridge and turn right – Follow the path through the trees – Past a house on the right out of the trees on to a track – Turn right and pass a sewage works on the left – On meeting a road continue straight on and walk into **Elton**. (6½ Miles)

- 6) Walk past **The Crown Inn** on the left and take the right fork at a green – Go past Stocks Green on the right and follow the road round to the left – Turn right into Chapel Lane – Walk to the end of the lane to where the road turns into a track and a bridleway - Follow the bridleway through three fields – On reaching a copse bear right around the trees to a bridge over a brook – Once over the bridge bear half right across the field towards some trees – Look for a path into the trees – The path emerges on the edge of the woods – Follow the path with a market garden (Poly Tunnels) on the left and the river through the trees on the right – The path meets a track – Turn right then keep to the left on a path that leads to the A605. (7¼ Miles)
- 7) Take a path by the edge of the road – At the end of the path turn left and cross the road to a path opposite – Climb the bank to more Poly Tunnels – The path turns sharp right almost back on yourself and go into a pasture field on the right – Turn left and walk to a gate on to a road – Turn right and follow the road into **Warmington** and back to the start.
