



Walk Description

Title: Weekley - Warkton - Circular

Map: OS Explorer 224

Distance: 3 Miles

Ascent: 157ft

Start: Weekly Wood Lane – Weekly - NN16 9UX – MapRef SP 88595 80854

- 1) Walk to the **A4300** Road – Cross the road and turn right and walk to the grass triangle – Ignore the first left turn but take the second left down a narrow lane between a barn on the left and a cottage on the right – Walk to the end of the lane and bear right on to a grass track – Pass a house on the left into a pasture field – Keep close to the hedge on the right and go through a gap in the hedge in front of you – Bear slightly left to a track – Turn right on to the track and walk to a road. (½ Mile)
- 2) Cross the road and turn left over the **River Ise** – Take a waymarked footpath on the right and follow the river on the right until you reach a footbridge on the right – Turn left on to a footpath which crosses two fields keeping a hedge on the right – At a T junction with a track turn left on to a bridleway and follow the bridleway – Walk to where the track bears right then almost immediately turn left through a gateway – Follow the bridleway towards some buildings – The path bears right to a road – Turn left and walk into **Warkton**. (1½ Miles)
- 3) Walk to a junction and turn right – Walk through the village to a T junction with **Pipe Lane** turn left walk to a road on the left – Turn left and walk to the **Church** – Retrace your steps back to **Pipe Lane** and turn left – Walk down the hill to the footbridge over the **River Ise** – Now retrace your steps by taking the bridleway on your right and walking along the track to a field – Here go straight on over the field aiming for some houses directly in front of you – Skirt to the right of a cottage to a road – Turn left and walk through **Weekly** back to the **A4300** – Turn right and then left into **Weekly Wood Lane** and the start.
